Ottawa Streetfest: Sept 28, 2019

We have had several visitors to the church assembly Sunday. One was a result of our work at the Ancaster Fair Bible quiz board. He lived nearby the building and brought his 2-year-old daughter. We also have three bible studies going on with non-Christians and one of them has attended twice.

We had our final outdoor Bible quiz evangelistic event. It is the Ottawa Streetfest that happens in October. Hundreds of people walk up and down the street visiting vendors and stores. We had about 5 members help man the booth. We would call people as they walked by, "take the bible quiz" or "Attend church with us this Sunday" or "Do you want to learn about Jesus" or "Are you interested in studying the Bible. We started at about 10 am. The event goes to 5pm, but we shut down at 3pm because of rain. We talked to many who also took the quiz but nobody attended church as a result.




Full-Preterism Refuted

Attached is a monograph refuting the AD 70 doctrine. **“Full-Preterists”** teach the “rapture/second coming occurred on Pentecost Sunday, AD 66 (22nd June) based upon Josephus’ 7th sign (Wars 6:296 is actually dated to Pentecost Sunday 2nd June AD 65) and date the book of Revelation to c. AD 62. The idea that the second coming of Christ happened on Pentecost AD 66, represents one of the most recent theological developments in the history of the church and is false. They believe there was a rapture on Pentecost AD 66 that removed every living Christian from the face of planet earth. “Left Behind” were all the lost, found unworthy of resurrection and eternal life. Yes, exactly like that horrible movie of the same title. After the Church of Christ went extinct on earth on Pentecost AD 66, sinners found the Bible, and like Josiah became Christians and restart the presence of the church on earth for a

second time down to the present. You can read it on-line for free by typing into Google search engine the phrase "Full-Preterism refuted" and my monograph is the first hit result in google.

San Diego: Mini gospel meeting and NEAS lecture: Nov 18-22, 2019

I flew to San Diego as a guest lecturer for the annual archaeological conference. My topic is the "Search for Kadesh Barnea". I use the Bible and ancient literary sources to locate Kadesh at Petra. Since AD 1916, the Early Bronze city of Kadesh Barnea that Abraham visited (En-mishpat, Gen 14:7) has been **wrongly located on every Bible map at Ein Qudeirat** where the earliest occupation is Iron II. Before this, Ein Qedeis, Ein Weibeh and Ein Hasb were all considered candidate locations. Analysis of the two excavation reports (Brian Byrd: 1989 and 2005) of the Early bronze city of El Beidha, located 5 km north of Petra, combined with ancient sources like Josephus, Eusebius' Onomasticon and the Madaba map and a careful tracing of the southern border of Judah from Joshua 15, demonstrate that the general area of Petra provides a perfect match of 14 identifier criteria from the Bible is where Kadesh Barnea where Israel spent 38 years from 1444-1406 BC.



Gospel Meeting: While I was in San Diego, I met with the local brethren at the Central congregation at 4790 Seminole Dr. San Diego three times. I enjoyed a Monday night home Bible study on the Smyrna church in Revelation led by one of the brothers. Then on Wednesday and Friday night I presented two lessons to the church. It was such goodness to meet with these precious brethren I had never met before, who live at the opposite end of my world in Canada.

MATTHEW 10

⁵ These twelve Jesus sent out, instructing them, “Go nowhere among the Gentiles and enter no town of the Samaritans, ⁶ but go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. ⁷ And proclaim as you go, saying, ‘The kingdom of heaven is at hand.’ ⁸ Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, cast out demons. You received without paying; give without pay

¹⁶ Behold, I am sending you out as sheep in the midst of wolves, so be wise as serpents and innocent as doves. ¹⁷ Beware of men, for they will deliver you over to courts and flog you in their synagogues, ¹⁸ and you will be dragged before governors and kings for my sake, to bear witness before them and the Gentiles. ¹⁹ When they deliver you over, do not be anxious how you are to speak or what you are to say, for what you are to say will be given to you in that hour. ²⁰ For it is not you who speak, but the Spirit of your Father speaking through you. ²¹ Brother will deliver brother over to death, and the father his child, and children will rise against parents and have them put to death, ²² and you will be hated by all for my name’s sake. But the one who endures to the end will be saved. ²³ When they persecute you in one town, flee to the next, for truly, I say to you, you will not have gone through all the towns of Israel before the Son of Man comes

²⁶ So have no fear of them, for nothing is covered that will not be revealed, or hidden that will not be known. ²⁷ What I tell you in the dark, say in the light, and what you hear whispered, proclaim on the housetops. ²⁸ And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell. ²⁹ Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? And not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your Father. ³⁰ But even the hairs of your head are all numbered. ³¹ Fear not, therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows. ³² So everyone who acknowledges me before men, I also will acknowledge before my Father who is in heaven, ³³ but whoever denies me before men, I also will deny before my Father who is in heaven.”

Underlined in those verses from Matthew 10 are just a few things Jesus informed his disciples of. It is amazing to read and reflect upon the magnitude of which Jesus' words must have meant to the men who were following him. Jesus choose to explain to his disciples exactly what they would face in the coming time while spreading the gospel.

How many of us would be willing to continue preaching when we knew that we would be persecuted, hated, and flogged? I wonder if the disciples fully understood what Jesus was explaining prior to watching what Jesus experienced at the end of his own life. As the disciples witnessed the end of Jesus' life, they must have been reminded of these words above. They must have gained strength in knowing that the man they served had been beaten and killed, just as they were facing themselves. We too should be able to gain strength in the life Jesus lived, as well as, the life these men lived. Jesus walked on this earth with full knowledge of what the end of his physical life looked like; however, he continued his work. The disciples continued their work, most to the point of death. Yet, both Jesus and his disciples were willing to teach and preach while on this earth. We must also teach and preach while on this earth.

I reflect on many things in my life, but I am not in fear of being beating or killed. So, what is my excuse? I do not have one. The disciples continued their earthly ministry with full knowledge of the physical pain it would cause. Their concern was spiritual things. We often say, "It's not about you." This is certainly true with the disciples of Jesus; it was not about anything they would suffer; it was about Jesus and spreading the gospel. As we approach a new year, let spreading the gospel be our focus, no matter what we may face.
