GOAL OF THIS LESSON

RESEARCH/STUDY ASSIGNMENTS


Find as many different categories or topics of Leviticus as you can. Be as thorough as you want or feel is necessary. I suggest you write all the chapters and verses affiliated with each category

Feel free to NOT read through Leviticus in making your list or chart. You could use Bible software or websites looking for key words or use the headings the publisher of your Bible inserts into the Scriptures (that's how I started)

If you're not sure how or where a passage fits into a category give the passage its own category or ad it to a miscellaneous category

Example:

Sacrifices: burnt offering ch1, grain offerings ch2, etc
The Priesthood: consecration of ch8, first offerings ch9, etc
miscellaneous: animals for food ch11, birth ch12, etc
Don't be like the nations: 20.22-26, 20.1-5, 6-8?

All of Leviticus


KEEP THESE THINGS IN MIND....
